Engine

- o Volvo D1-30 diesel/sail drive, all new 2008 (60 eng. hours), 28 HP still under warranty
- o Bronze, two-blade Volvo folding propeller
- o Primary diesel/ water separator fuel filter fuel
- o Never exposed to salt water
- o New diesel fuel tank (2006)

Rig, Sails, Deck Hardware

- o Black Schafer 200 series mast & boom (very sturdy) – “tall mast” version of Aloha 34
